HISTORY OF POINTE COUPEE PARISH

French-Canadian explorer Pierre Le Moyne, sieur d'Iberville and his brother, Jean-Baptiste Le Moyne de Bienville, sailed from Brest, France in late 1698, arriving at the lower Mississippi River in 1699 to establish a colony in New World for King Louis XIV.

While the explorers and their traveling party were out exploring the land, their Indian guides led them along a six foot wide stream through dense forest. The explorers were mystified to find a point where the huge river doubled back on itself, forming an oxbow. That site was later named "la Pointe Coupee," the place of the cut off.

The fort "Poste de Pointe Coupee" was established by Bienville in 1717 at a site known later as Waterloo. The fort was moved in 1722 to an area near the present St. Francisville Ferry landing.

Over the years, nature widened the stream which became the riverbed for the mighty Mississippi. Eventually, both ends of the giant oxbow closed, forming a 22 mile horseshoe-shaped lake. This lake was known as "la Fausee Rivere", and is now named False River.

The rich, alluvial lands where the Mississippi River once flowed attracted farmers. Tobacco and indigo were grown initially, and now sugar cane and other varieties of crops are grown, including pecans, cotton, soybeans, corn and rice are raised in the fertile soil.

The United States acquired the Louisiana Purchase from France in 1803. With the enactment of the Louisiana Constitution of 1812, Pointe Coupee Became one of the State of Louisiana's 12 original parishes.

Pointe Coupee Parish has long been called "The Cradle of Public Education in Louisiana". In March 1808, a Louisiana law was enacted providing for parish school boards. Pointe Coupee was the first parish in the state to implement the Act and establish public schools.

In 1975, the first "Tuscaloosa Trend" natural gas discovery was made in Pointe Coupee Parish and was claimed to be the richest mineral deposit in Louisiana.

Today, Pointe Coupee Parish is best known for its agriculture, recreation and tourism industries. Agriculture is the largest income-producer in Pointe Coupee Parish, with gross revenues of about \$50 million annually. Pointe Coupee is the top pecan-producing parish in the state, with some of the best quality nuts grown anywhere. The fastest expanding crops in the parish are sugar cane and cotton while soybeans, corn, wheat and grain sorghum (milo) are other major crops. Livestock production of beef cattle is another major agriculture force in the region.

False River, designated as a Trophy Bass Lake, has held the state record for the largest bass caught although all water sports are enjoyed here. Pointe Coupee Parish is also blessed with Old River, a smaller oxbow-shaped lake with great fishing potential.

The French plantation country heritage of Pointe Coupee Parish is evident in the many historic homes of the area, many of which are listed in the National Register of Historic Places. A unique feature of these Pointe Coupee homes is that these are truly family homes – none are museum-only restorations. Pointe Coupee is also graced with several elegantly refurbished Bed and Breakfast opportunities.

Pointe Coupee Parish is home to approximately 23,500 people and boasts four banks, a modern hospital and health care facilities, educational institutions at all levels and easy access to Baton Rouge, New Orleans, Lafayette and the rest of Louisiana. A commercial airport and modern accessible port facility, round out the business advantages of Pointe Coupee Parish.

Pointe Coupee Parish contains 15,360 acres of water, 75,000 acres of pastures; and 150,000 acres of forests. Bordered on three sides by inland waterways – Old River, the Atchafalaya River and the Mississippi River – Pointe Coupee Parish is best known for its water and outdoor recreation activities.

Points of Interest

Alma Plantation Sugar Mill (Lakeland) – A working sugar mill set on the grounds of this plantation home built in 1789, Alma Plantation produces raw sugar and black strap molasses. Built by noted philanthropist Julien Poydras and now owned and operated by the Stewart Family, Alma Plantation continues as one of the few working sugar plantations in the entire southern portion of the United States. The home is no longer open to the public, but the sugar mill and a country store are open to visitors.

Bergeron Brothers Pecan Shelling Plant (New Roads) – Employing about 60 workers, this plant processes an average of three million pounds of pecans each year, 600,000 pounds of which are shipped nationwide. Established in 1940, this family-owned plant offers free tours from October through March.

Cherie Quarters Cabins (Oscar) - The two single-story slave dwellings, which remain on the historic Riverlake Plantation, are known as the Cherie Quarters Cabins. These buildings are significant because they are rare surviving examples of a once common antebellum building type which has all but disappeared from the state. Cherie Quarters was the birthplace and childhood home of African-American author Ernest J. Gaines.

Conquest Plantation (New Roads) – Built in 1888, this Victorian home was fully restored to reflect Pointe Coupee’s 19th century aura. It can be found on Pointe Coupee Road.

False River Lake (Pointe Coupee Parish) – One of the most noted oxbow lakes in the lower Mississippi Delta, False River was the main channel of the Mississippi River until about 1722 when seasonal flooding cut a shorter channel to the east. False River, a 22-mile long “trophy-

lake,” is known today for boating, skiing, sailing and fishing. Between 1974 and 1981, more than 265,000 striped bass fingerlings were released into this lake which covers 3,212 acres.

False River Air Park (New Roads) - This airport is located on 103 acres. The air park boasts a hard surfaced runway 5,000 feet long and 75 feet wide which is lighted from dusk ‘til dawn and has three FAA-approved instrument approaches. The facility includes a terminal building with 24 hour fast pay fueling system. There are 14 T-hangars, 3 privately owned hangars and now has a Solar/LED Taxiway Lighting System. The False River Airport is part of the National Airport System.

Glynnwood Plantation (Glynn) – Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, Glynnwood Plantation was constructed in 1836. After years of additions, this 11 bedroom house has been created into a unique architectural style.

John J. Audubon Bridge (New Roads/St. Francisville) – The John J. Audubon Bridge, opened in 2011, connects Pointe Coupee and West Feliciana parishes and replaces the existing ferry. The bridge spans 1/3 of a mile over the Mississippi River. It is the longest cable-stayed bridge in the Western Hemisphere.

Lakeside Plantation (Batchelor) – Lakeside is a unique and historic plantation located in Batchelor, LA. It was constructed in 1835.

LeJeune House (New Roads) – Built around 1820 of primarily Louisiana colonial architecture, this home also boasts many classic features including Greek Revival cypress paneling. The LeJeune House was extensively remodeled in the late 1850’s by the French architect Francois Avernant. Most of the eastern portion of the City of New Roads was formed by the subdivision of the Samson LeJeune plantation in 1909.

Parlange Plantation (New Roads) – Built in 1750 by the Marquis Viscent de Ternant, Parlange was constructed of bousilliage (mud, moss and deer hair) and cypress set over a hand-made brick raised basement. The home remains in the possession of the Marquis’ descendants, the Parlange family. This National Historic Landmark features magnificent furnishings and paintings which are original to the home. Parlange is the most readily identified monument of Pointe Coupee’s legendary history. Parlange can be found on False River Road five miles southwest of New Roads.

Pointe Coupee Parish Museum and Tourist Center (New Roads) – On the bank of False River, the Pointe Coupee Parish Museum and Tourist Center is housed in a unique Creole cottage built in the late 1700s. The Museum features a rare double-pitched roof. Open year round, the Tourist Center is located on Louisiana Highway 1 six miles south of New Roads.

Pointe Coupee Port and Industrial Park (Lettsworth) – The only dock facility between Baton Rouge and Natchez, nearly 100 acres of port-owned land with all utilities are available for development on the protected side of the levee. This facility offers a floating barge, a 300-foot reinforced concrete finger dock, four mooring dolphins, an 80-ton crane, access road and parking area. The port’s navigation channel is 12 feet deep and 250 feet wide.

Poydras Monument (New Roads) – Julien Poydras, known as “the father of public education in Louisiana”, lies buried under this octagonal monument in front of Poydras High School in New Roads. Born in France in 1744, he traveled to the New World and established a store in Pointe Coupee in 1769. A successful merchant, banker, plantation owner and a national political figure, Julien Poydras was instrumental in founding the first public schools in Louisiana. Poydras was never married, because, according to legend, his intended bride lacked a dowry. His will continues to this day to supply dowries for the poor brides of Pointe Coupee and West Baton Rouge.

Riverlake Plantation (Oscar) – Set on the west bank of the False River, construction on Riverlake began around 1820 and continued until 1890. Riverlake is one of a select group of major Creole raised plantation houses which are Pointe Coupee Parish's largest and oldest buildings.

St. Francis Chapel (New Roads) – The original structure was completed in 1728 at the Post of Pointe Coupee. A new church was constructed in 1760, but built too close to the Mississippi River. Graves from the church’s graveyard were soon consumed by the rushing waters. The church was dismantled and a smaller version was built using materials from the previous church. It was dedicated in 1895. Known as the fourth oldest continuously operating Catholic Church in Louisiana, St. Francis Chapel is now a mission church of St. Mary’s of False River. The town of St. Francisville is named for the St. Francis Chapel.

St. Mary’s Catholic Church (New Roads) – Built in 1907 to house the fourth oldest Catholic community in Louisiana, St. Mary’s Catholic Church on Main Street in New Roads boasts beautiful Gothic Revival architecture. St. Mary’s interior treasures include magnificently carved altars, Way of the Cross oil paintings and German stained glass windows portraying the Mysteries of the Rosary and other subjects. The original structure, “St. Mary’s of False River,” was built in 1823 and was made an independent parish in 1865.

St. Stephen’s Episcopal Church (Innis) – This Church was built near Innis in 1858 and consecrated by the famed “Fighting Bishop of the Confederacy”, Bishop Leonidas Polk. St. Stephens is thought to be the oldest brick structure in the parish. Its cemetery contains a Civil War monument to the unknown soldiers of the confederacy.

Tri-Parish Cotton Gin (Lettsworth) – Employing nearly 30 workers, this gin produces an average of 25,000 bales of cotton each year.

White Hall Plantation (Lettsworth) – White Hall survived shelling from Union gunboats during the Civil War. On the bank of the Atchafalaya River, White Hall has been moved several times throughout the years to escape the river’s tumultuous wrath. Employing nearly 30 workers, this gin produces an average of 25,000 bales of cotton each year.

Wickliffe, Circa 1820 (Ventress) – Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, Wickliffe is a two-story raised French Creole-type plantation home. Built on the original natural levee of the Mississippi River, Wickliffe was named after a once bustling but now forgotten community.
